

NDDP Students Pass With Flying Colours

Newgen's Digital Discovery Paathshala (NDDP) is successfully transforming classroom sessions into fun-learning activities. And, to ensure its success, we follow a robust monitoring mechanism. We regularly conduct revisions and assessments for the students to gauge their learning and retention abilities on the topics taught.

To test the waters, we recently conducted an assessment for 7th standard students. The test was designed in a MCQ (Multiple Choice Question) format to analyse the analytical and cognitive skills of the students.

The Question papers comprised two separate sets to avoid scope for cheating. Further, to avoid discrepancy, one of the set was designed with easier questions for the weaker sections (D and E) as compared to other sections (A, B and C). The questions were based on the topics discussed in the classroom through AVs and I-Pad sessions. Post the test, our team carefully examined and evaluated the solution sheets.

Interestingly, the students performed well. Nearly 49% of the students (175 out of 358 students) scored above 50% marks in the tests.

The good performers of each section were given prizes to motivate them and to set an example for rest of the students. In the future, we plan to focus on students who scored less than 50%. The endeavour of our CSR team is to help all the students excel in the future assessments.

We understand that this is only the beginning, and **we have a long way to go.**
