Walking through the imaginative realm with pleasant instrumental music playing in the background was an exquisite affair for the students as well as volunteers. Ms Renuka Taneja, a graduate from College of Art has been organizing art exhibition annually for past fourteen years. These exhibitions are culmination of art done by students the whole year. She, a National Institute of Design alumna, started Windows Art and Craft Studio in Delhi 14 years ago, the idea was to create artwork from different items. She worked with the kids using art and craft media (sketching and painting with acrylic on different surfaces exploring dry pastels) to help children create something in a boundary less way. Children are encouraged to explore nature and express themselves through multiple art and craft media. Her studio also helps nurture the value of environmental sensitivity through use of recycled materials.

The year round students re-used the objects/materials which were disposed, to create something exuberant and beautiful. Five Sadbhavna children were taken to this exhibition. They were quite amazed to see how the disposed objects, can be reused to make such wonderful items. With every piece of art there was a story and a pen prototype. The idea to first think of a story, draw a prototype and then start making the final craft was really plausible. The idea to use the used items ranging from threading reel to old newspapers, candle wax to cardboard rolls, from discarded CDs to egg shells, was indeed wonderful. The best part about the exhibition was the fact every art piece overflowed with innocence and imagination of the children of varied age groups.
